The team have a great deal of experience in supporting people who have a whole range of different needs, including support for people who have complex packages of care organised.

We can provide medical support and personal care, as well as other tailor made arrangements to best suit you.

We put together bespoke arrangements, with no calls less than an hour, and we will ensure you have consistency, with the same PA coming to you on the same day and time each week.

## We're trusted

We've supported Marcus since October 2019, enabling him to remain in work. He remembers the date because that's the day his life changed.

## We go the extra mile

We helped Marcus in other ways, fixing things around the home to make life easier.

We organised things like hoists and kitchen equipment with lowered surfaces so that Marcus can cook and use the kitchen. Marcus' PAs are happy to be flexible and work to suit his needs.

Sometimes he will request calls to be earlier or later, but this allows him to live his life the way he chooses.
